Most recently she has been diagnosed with cancer, which has required hospitalization, medication and chemotherapy. All of which have exhausted her medical insurance. Currently, Roseleen is going through radiation treatment (in Mumbai). On her previous trips to Mumbai, she was able to take someone with her as she required assistance. This means 2 air tickets, hotel accommodation and food. Her funds are now exhausted and she has to travel to Mumbai on her own. Unfortunately, she has no family or friends in Mumbai to assist her. Her family has assisted with the payment of some of her bills which have amounted to approximately \$10,000.00
